

Craft Stalls

Please read this entire document as it includes details of how the Craft Fairs are run on the day and what is expected of the Stallholder and the Museum. By booking your stall you are accepting the terms and conditions as set out below.

Location - The Craft Fair will be upstairs in the Singer Room (mezzanine).

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payment terms

Craft stalls must be paid for **before** the event.

Cancellation:

- Less than 14 days notice of cancellation no refund will be given
- More than 14 days notice of cancellation 50% refund will be returned

Unloading and Loading

Friday drop off available by arrangement only, between 2pm and 4pm.

Access will be via Cook Street Car Park at the rear of the Museum, from 8.00am each day. A steward will be available to direct you. Please bring your own trolleys if you can. **NB** Please note, this is a staff car park and during unloading this area gets very busy and you may have to wait to access your stall, please be patient and considerate to other car park users and stall holders. You are <u>not</u> permitted to leave your vehicle in this car park.

Further instructions will be posted to you approximately two weeks prior to the event.

Car Parking

Please make your own parking arrangements after unloading as there is no parking at the Museum. We suggest you use Belgrade Plaza Car Park on the Saturday as we have negotiated a reduce rate with them for Saturday. We recommend Bishop Street Car Park on the Sunday which is £1 for the whole day.

Provided for you

You will be provided with a wooden trestle table, approximately 6ft by 2ft, and two chairs. You will need to supply your own table covering(s). Tables will be laid out and labelled before stall holders arrive, please look for the correct stall or ask where it is.

If you are trading for more than one day you will be able to leave your stall set up overnight on the Saturday and/or Sunday. There is no public access to the building from 5pm closing till opening at 10am the following morning.

Required from you

Advertising and/or displays must not be attached to walls without prior arrangement with the Museum.

All items for stall must be as listed on the booking form, if other items not listed on your booking form are on display you may be asked to remove them. All items <u>must be handmade or hand crafted</u>.

Stall holders found to have 'bought' in items may be asked to remove them from sale.

If you bring a child or children with you, please note that they are your responsibility and should not be permitted to run freely around the Museum.

Traders should be ready to trade by **10:00am**. Please make sure there are no trip hazards and walkways are not obstructed. **No trader should dismantle their display before 4.30pm on any day without prior agreement with the organiser on site.** Your space is to be left tidy at the end of the day and any rubbish put in the bins. Please return plates and cups to the cafe.

Any electrical equipment which is brought on site must be tested/certified to the appropriate standards and should carry a current PAT testing label. Electrical leads for external use must be fitted with 16A plugs. Electric is only to be used for lights - not kettles or similar.

All Stallholders have a duty of care to ensure their own Health & Safety, and also that of members of the public. They are responsible for any and all damage or injury to persons or property caused by them or their stands or any act of omission by them or their staff. Traders are responsible for holding their own Public Liability Insurance and Product Liability Insurance.
